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SYNOPSIS

A love story through the eye of a spider drone. Across the landscape of a North African desert and an oil pipeline, appears a strange spider-like robot that seems to be scoping the horizon. At the other end of the world, in America, Gordon, drone operator and safe keeper of the pipeline, surveys the desolated landscapes from his screens. Having lost his way in a world he no longer comprehends, he becomes fascinated by Ayusha, a young woman promised to an older man she doesn't love. Despite the distance, their mutual fear and their imperfect interaction, Gordon will do everything in his power to help Ayusha escape her fate, falling for her in the process.



This film is a utopion reverie, kind of like the daydreams of Louis Armstrong's songs, kind of like What a Wonderful World, it fantasizes about breaking the walls of technologies and orthodoxies that separate us in so many ways. It is also, I hope, a modern tale about how humans strive to engage with one another, understand each other, inside this confusing Global Village that is at once so small, and at times so distancing.

KIM NGUYEN DIRECTOR'S STATEMEN

In 2002, Kim Nguyen wrote and directed his first feature: Le Marais. The film received 6 Jutra nominations including Best Film and Best Director. His second feature. Truffe, which he wrote, directed and produced, stars Roy Dupuis and was the opening film at Montreal's FANTASIA Film Festival in 2008. It also garnered international awards including "Best Film" at the Karlovy Vary Fresh Film Festival. In 2009 he directed La Cité, an international co-production starring Jean Marc Barr, WAR WITCH (REBELLE) has been sold in over 25 territories and has been nominated for Best Foreign Language Film at the 2013 Academy Awards WAR WITCH was nominated for Best International Film at the 28th Film Independent Spirit Awards and also won the Silver Bear for Best Actress at the 2012 Berlinale, Best Narrative Film and Best Actress at TriBeCa Film Festival. In 2015, Kim Nguyen has directed his first documentary: THE NOSE and his first English-language film: TWO LOVERS AND A REAR selected at Cannes Film Festival in 2016. Jesse Eisenberg and Alexander Skarsgård are set to star in Kim Nguyen's next film The Hummingbird Project presently in pre-production.
