

Guðmundur Arnar Guðmundsson (Islanda, 1982) si laurea presso l'Accademia Islandese d'Arte e, successivamente, si trasferisce in Danimarca per studiare sceneggiatura. I suoi cortometraggi ricevono numerosi riconoscimenti. Tra questi, il pluripremiato *Hvalfjörður* (*Whale Valley*), presentato nella Selezione Ufficiale del Festival di Cannes (Menzione Speciale) e nominato agli European Film Awards. Sviluppa e scrive la sua opera prima, *Hjartasteinn*, durante il suo soggiorno a Cannes nel Récidence du Cinéfondation. Nella fase di preparazione il film riceve anche un premio dalla Netherlands Production Platform.

Guðmundur Arnar Guðmundsson (Iceland, 1982) graduated from the Icelandic Art Academy. After graduation he moved to Denmark and studied screenwriting. His short films have been selected for more than 200 festivals and won over 50 international awards. Among these accolades are a Special Mention for *Whale Valley* (2013) in the Official Competition of the Cannes Film Festival and a nomination for the European Film Awards. Guðmundsson developed and wrote his first feature film *Heartstone* during a Cannes Cinéfondation Residency. While in development, *Heartstone* also received an award from the Netherlands Production Platform.
